HAGMAN APPOINTS EARL DEVRIES TO FISH & GAME

SAN BERNARDINO, CA – Supervisor Curt Hagman announced the appointment of Earl DeVries to the Fish & Game Commission. The Board of Supervisors unanimously voted to confirm the appointment, early this morning, during their Regular Meeting.

Earl DeVries, a long-time resident of Ontario, is an active volunteer in the community. He frequently volunteers at Salem Christian Homes for the Handicapped and is known for helping Water for Wild Life, an organization that protects and helps the game and animal population flourish. In addition to his volunteer work, Earl serves as the Co-Chairman of the West Valley Friends of the NRA.

“Earl is a fixture in the community and is known for his compassion and assistance to others. His background in community service and reputation for helping others will no doubt be an asset to the Fish & Game Commission and their efforts,” said Hagman.

The Fish & Game Committee acts as the liaison between the State Department of Fish and Game, the County Board of Supervisors, and the public. The Commission makes recommendations to the Board on matters pertaining to wildlife in San Bernardino County. Commissioners serve a total of four years.

Supervisor Curt Hagman was elected in November 2014 to represent the Fourth District, which includes the cities of Chino, Chino Hills, Ontario, Montclair and Upland (partial).
