## **Hagman Announces Animal Adoption Event with Priceless Pets**

CHINO HILLS – Supervisor Curt Hagman announced today a partnership with the Priceless Pets pet orphanage to hold an adoption event on August 27, 2016 from 11AM to 2PM. Supervisor Hagman will be providing the first bag of food for each new animal adopted that day.

The event is aimed to help adopt out as many animals as possible from The Orphanage, one of Priceless Pets' facilities in Chino Hills. Mr. Hagman said that he is glad to provide the food for any family, so that more pets will be adopted and find loving homes.

According to the ASPCA, 7.6 Million animals enter shelters each year, the majority of them being dogs and cats. Supervisor Hagman believes, as do many other Americans, that all animals deserve loving homes where they can be cared for and loved, and where they can truly become part of the family.

Priceless Pets began in 2007 as a foster based rescue, where community members would foster animals until they were ready and able to be adopted. Almost 9 years later, they now have two storefront centers in Chino Hills and Claremont. They currently work to make sure that all their animals are spayed/neutered, microchipped, before they leave the adoption center so that there is as little of a financial burden as possible on the adopters.
