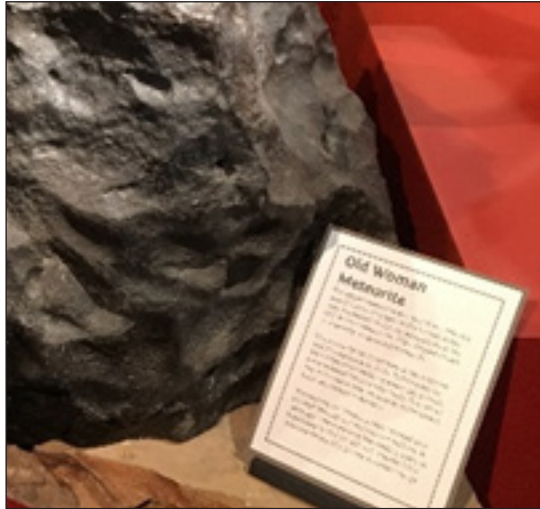


Earth Science Scavenger Hunt

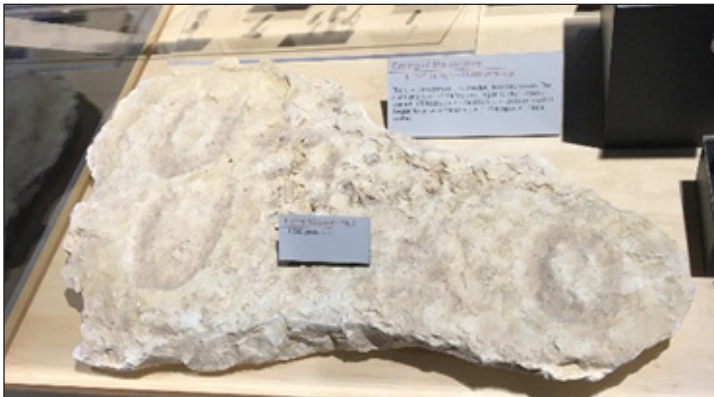
In celebration of Earth Science week, find all of the items related to fossils, rocks, and earthquakes. Put your detective skills to the test to find all of the items on the list!



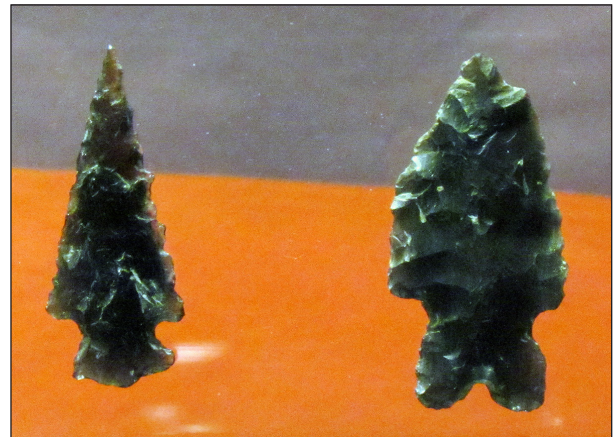
Find the largest meteorite ever discovered in California. How much does it weigh?



What two faults are you between on this spot?



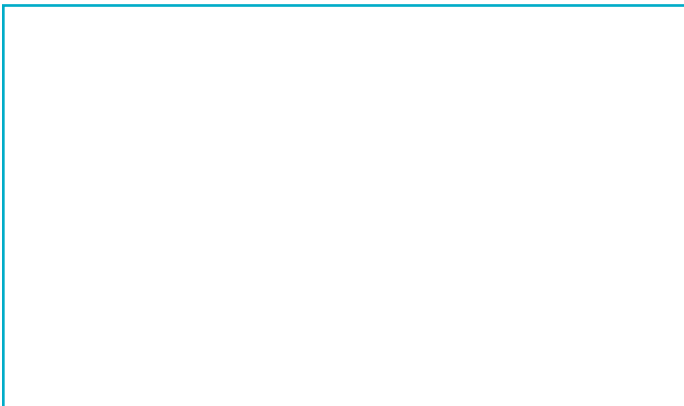
These hooved animals left their tracks in mud. What animals did they belong to? How old are their tracks?
