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Board Approves Contract to Resurface San Antonio Heights Roads

SAN BERNARDINO—October 21, 2014—More than two dozen roads in the unincorporated community of San Antonio Heights are going to get a makeover thanks to a \$653,266 contract approved by the San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors Tuesday.

“This is the culmination of a major road project the county started last year by resurfacing about nine miles of roadways in San Antonio Heights,” San Bernardino County Second District Supervisor Janice Rutherford said. “As with all road projects, there will be some minor inconveniences for motorists, but I encourage residents to be patient and drive slow in the construction zones.”

The project is scheduled to begin in mid-November and should be completed by the end of December barring weather or other unforeseen delays.

Portions of the following roads are scheduled to be resurfaced: Beck Street, Broadview Avenue, Canyon Drive, Elizabeth Court, Euclid Avenue, Glendale Road, Hidden Lane, Hillcrest Drive, Kilbourne Drive, Lamplighter Lane, Linda Lane, Mesa Terrace, Mountain Drive, Newman Street, Ocean View, Paloma Curve, Park Boulevard, Ravina Curve, Rosedale Curve, San Antonio Avenue, San Antonio Crest East, San Antonio Crest West, Sierra Drive, Sunset Court, Sunset Curve, Terrace Drive, 23rd Street and 24th Street.
