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City of Fontana and County of San Bernardino Partner on Road Improvements

SAN BERNARDINO – Sept. 27, 2011 – The San Bernardino County Board of Supervisors approved two cooperative agreements with the City of Fontana on Tuesday to repave and repair two roadways that traverse both County and City areas.

“The County of San Bernardino and City of Fontana share responsibility for a number of roads because of the substantial amount of unincorporated area within the City’s sphere of influence, and by working together, we can deliver the most comprehensive road improvements to benefit our residents and businesses,” Rutherford said.

The first agreement calls the County and City to contribute \$798,249 and \$148,665 respectively to pay for repaving Calabash Avenue between Whittram Avenue and Foothill Boulevard. Construction is expected to begin in the spring of 2012.

The second agreement requires the County and City to contribute \$230,178 and \$30,443 respectively toward the cost of slurry sealing the pavement on Randall Avenue between Cherry Avenue and Popular Avenue and between Cherry Avenue and Catawba Avenue. The work is scheduled to begin in late October.

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
