Pedestrian killed on Highway 138 near Wrightwood

WRIGHTWOOD, Calif. (VVNG.com) — Officers with the California Highway Patrol are currently investigating a fatal traffic collision here Monday morning.

The crash was reported at about 4:40 am, on February 12, 2018, on Highway 138, west of Highway 2 in Wrightwood.

According to **San Bernardino County Fire** spokesman Eric Sherwin, Medic Engine 10 arrived on scene at 4:53 am, and confirmed one deceased party at the scene.

Details regarding the crash are scarce, however, motorist driving by described seeing a middle aged female near the intersection, deceased.

The cause of the crash is currently under investigation by the CHP- Victorville office. Information will be updated as it becomes available.

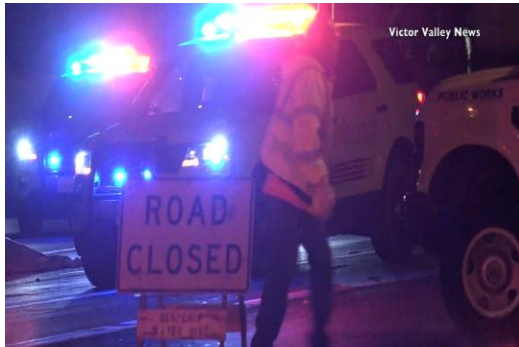
CHP is also working a separate incident along Sheep Creek Road and Highway 138 involving a single vehicle off the roadway and down an embankment. The incident was reported at 5:03 am, and no injuries were reported in this incident.

Palmdale Road closed after pedestrian killed in Victorville

VICTORVILLE, Calif. (VVNG.com) — Authorities have shut down a stretch of Palmdale Road after a female pedestrian was struck and killed by a vehicle Sunday night.

At about 8:45 pm, San Bernardino County Sheriff's Deputies along with **San Bernardino County Fire** responded to the area of Palmdale Road and Emerald Road where they found an unconscious female lying in the roadway.

According to a witness, the body of the unidentified pedestrian was covered with a yellow tarp moments after emergency personnel pronounced her deceased at the scene.

Officials confirmed the driver of a Ford F-150 pick-up truck remained at the scene, and called 911 immediately after the crash.

The Major Accident Investigation Team (MAIT) responded and is conducting the investigation into the crash.

East and westbound Palmdale Road between Cobalt Road and Cantina Drive will be shutdown for approximately 4-6 hours while authorities investigate.

Anyone who may have witnessed the accident is asked to call the Victorville Police Department at 760-241-2911.

Man reportedly shot in Victorville Shopping Center

VICTORVILLE, Calif. (VVNG.com) — A man was reportedly shot outside a busy shopping center Friday morning in Victorville.

The incident, which at some point involved a large fight that was recorded and posted to the Victor Valley News Facebook group, occurred at about 1:40 a.m. on the 12400 block of Mariposa Road.

According to Eric Sherwin, Spokesman for the **San Bernardino County Fire** Department, they were dispatched to reports of shots fired, but were cancelled by the Sheriff's Department when a victim wasn't found at the scene.

"We got (information) from the Sheriff, who got the 911 call, saying approximately 20 people were fighting at the Tilted Kilt," Sherwin said.

According to public records, when deputies responded to the location, one person was arrested and booked for Attempted Murder.

Cell phone footage posted to the Victor Valley News Group shows at least one man holding his leg while trying to run through the parking lot. Seconds later, a man rushes him and starts fighting. Eventually you could see about 4-6 men continuing to fight throughout the clip.

Victor Valley News reached out to Tilted Kilt and spoke with Issac Abraham, a manager at the restaurant.

"This happened all the way over by Vallarta, nothing happened inside," Abraham said. "It was not even close to Tilted Kilt."

Abraham told Victor Valley News that no employees or customers were involved in the incident.

The Sheriff's Department has not confirmed any details on the incident as of Sunday morning.

No additional information on the suspect or the victim, if any, has been released. Check back for updates.
