A single-vehicle rollover around 6 p.m. on May 10 left two juvenile passengers with minor injuries and complaints of pain, but neither one required transportation to a hospital, according to Officer T. Kittredge of the California Highway Patrol (CHP) Arrowhead office in Running Springs.

The driver was not injured when the accident occurred north of the stoplight near State Highway 189 and Lake Gregory Drive. Three **San Bernardino County Fire** units responded to the scene.

Speed was not a factor, the official report stated, as the vehicle was traveling at approximately 35 mph in a 55 mph zone. Apparently, the 2007 Mazda 3 drifted off to the right side, collided with a concrete culvert and flipped onto its roof.
