Hesperia City Council meeting: What's on the agenda

HESPERIA — The Council will meet on Tuesday night to discuss a handful of items that pertain to the city of Hesperia, chief among them an attempt to have the **San Bernardino County Fire District** annex the Hesperia Fire Protection District.

- The Council will vote on a resolution that requests the Local Agency Formation Commission begin reorganization proceedings to annex the Hesperia Fire Protection District to the San Bernardino County Fire District. The goal of the proposed annexation is to reduce the cost of fire protection services to the city while maintaining or improving services, the Council told the Daily Press.
- A public hearing over the adoption of a resolution that would see a substantial amendment to the Community Development Block Grant Consolidated Plan by adding one strategic plan goal and amending the numeric goals. The amendment would cancel seven activities totaling \$1.4 million and reprogram the funds to Street Improvement Projects activity. The amendment would impact the Microenterprise Assistance Program, Economic Development Loan Program and the Sidewalk, Curb, Gutter and ADA Ramp Improvement Project.
- •The discussion to approve the procurement of four new vehicles and award the bid to Fairview Ford Sales, with a price not-to-exceed \$141,061.92. The goal is to replace aging and costly vehicles purchased nearly 10 years ago. The current fiscal year budget included funds for the replacement of two animal control vehicles that were purchased in 2008, but not two trucks in the water division that have experienced complete engine failure.
