VICTORVILLE, Calif. (VVNG.com) — Two people in a pick-up truck were critically injured following an early morning crash here Wednesday.

It happened just before 6:00 am, along the 16500 block of D Street in Victorville.

For reasons still unknown, a male driver in a white Toyota Tacoma was driving eastbound on D Street approaching First Street when he lost control and jumped over the curb. The truck smashed into a block wall and eventually came to a stop in the parking lot of the Beck Oil gas pumps at the corner of Second Street.

Firefighters with **San Bernardino County Fire** requested an airship to transport a female passenger to an out of area trauma center. According to a witness at the scene, a female adult passenger was partially pinned under the dashboard and was critically injured.

The male driver was transported to a local hospital with unknown injuries.

The collision remains under investigation and no other vehicles were involved.

VICTORVILLE, Calif. (VVNG.com) — A male motorcyclist was airlifted to a trauma center after he was involved in a traffic collision with a vehicle here Tuesday afternoon.

It happened at about 1:20 p.m. on Seventh Street near Tracey Street in Victorville and involved a dark-orange Harley Davidson and a black Acura sedan.

San Bernardino County Sheriff's Deputies, **SB County Fire Department** and AMR responded and located a male rider on the ground suffering from unknown injuries.

The male was responsive and alert during the time of transport. The driver of the black sedan involved in the crash remained on scene and cooperated with officials and did not appear to be injured.

"It appears the driver of the Acura was attempting to turn into a driveway on 7th and turned into the path of the motorcycle, which was traveling northbound on 7th," stated Sheriff's Spokeswoman Mara Rodriguez.

As the temperature continues to rise across Southern California, many riders are sure to be on the roadway enjoying the weather. Please be sure to triple check your surroundings for everyone's safety.
