Early Morning Structure Fire Damages Tire Shop

Date/Time: February 11, 2105, 7:48am

Location: 17000 Block of Mesa Street in Hesperia, CA

Incident: Commercial Structure Fire

Summary: At 7:48 am on February 11, San Bernardino County Fire Department units were dispatched to a commercial structure fire at the 17000 block of Mesa Street in Hesperia, CA.

Upon arrival San Bernardino County Fire companies reported a single story commercial repair garage with heavy smoke coming from the building. Firefighters engaged in an aggressive fire attack and knocked the fire down within fifteen minutes. The building contained a large number of vehicle tires that fueled the flames and produced a large amount of smoke.

A total of 3 fire engines, 1 truck company and 1 battalion chief from Victorville and Hesperia responded to the fire. There were no injuries to civilians or firefighters. Damages were estimated at \$50,000.00. The fire is under investigation and no cause was yet determined at the time of this press release.
