From serving on a hot shot crew, fire fighting engine companies, to management, rising through the ranks of the U.S. Forest Service to Division Chief on the San Bernardino National Forest, Mike has experience in all aspects of fire fighting and emergency management. Chief Wakoski has served as the Incident Commander of U.S. Forest Service Southern California Incident Management Team 3 for the past 4 years and will continue to serve in that capacity. Prior to this, he served over 25 years in various roles on incident management teams.

Chief Wakoski will focus his efforts on the further development of County Fire Hand Crews, ensuring their readiness in fire fighting and will assist in the development of the County Fire emergency medical service and fire fighting helicopter program. Mike will also serve a role on the San Bernardino County Incident Management Team.

Chief Wakoski has a certificate in wildland studies from Humboldt State University and an Associate degree in fire science.

Mike and wife Noelle have two children in college and are committed to their family and community. They are all outdoor enthusiasts and enjoy most activities from the desert and mountain regions to the beautiful ocean.
