1 Person Airlifted, 3 Others Injured in Highway 395 Head-On Crash

VICTORVILLE, Calif. (VVNG.com) A four-vehicle traffic collision that injured 4 people temporarily closed Highway 395 Monday afternoon.

The multi-vehicle traffic collision was reported at 6:28 p.m. between Mojave Drive and Seneca Road on Highway 395. The accident involved a red minivan, and two Toyota sedans with major damage. A fourth vehicle was side swiped and pulled into the Stater Brothers parking lot.

“We arrived on scene within eight minutes and located three vehicles with major damage. There were no parties trapped fortunately. However, we had three delayed patients (minor injuries) and one immediate patient (with) a serious non-life threatening injury,” stated Captain Jeff Allen with the **San Bernardino County Fire Department**.

An air ambulance was requested to fly the patient to an Antelope Valley trauma center.

Highway 395 was closed while the San Bernardino County Sheriff’s Department conducted the investigation.

FONTANA, Calif. (KABC) –

Firefighters early Tuesday morning extinguished a fire that damaged part of a strip mall in Fontana.

The blaze was reported shortly after 2 a.m. at the single-story location near Sierra and San Bernardino avenues, according to the **San Bernardino Fire Department**.

Firefighters arrived at the scene to find intense flames and smoke emanating from the roof of the building, which was not equipped with sprinklers, investigators said. The fire did not affect the interior of the strip mall, which remained structurally sound.

Three businesses were damaged in the fire.

The cause of the incident is under investigation.

The classes will be held Friday from 5 to 9 p.m., and Saturday and Sunday, May 20 and 21, from 8 to 5. All classes will be held at the Twentynine Palms Senior Center on Adobe Road in Twentynine Palms. Volunteers will learn about personal preparedness, disaster training, medical operations and triage, terrorism, incident command system, fire safety, search and rescue, and more. After completion of the program, volunteers will receive a CERT manual, safety helmet, backpack, safety vest, and the knowledge to help their community during a crisis or disaster.
