## ***County Fire Makes Quick Knockdown Saving Home***

***On Tuesday March 1st at 5:00 p.m. #SBCoFD received reports of a structure fire at the 14800 block of Coachman road in the City of #Victorville. Initial reports stated that there was a bedroom involved in fire with smoke throughout the house. Residence advised all occupants were out of the house prior to unit's arrival.***

***County Fire Medic Engine 312 arrived on scene in five minutes to find a working fire on the second story of a two-story residence. Firefighters were able to make a quick knock down, containing the fire to one bedroom. Fire was under control within 8 minutes of the first engine company's arrival. Damage was kept to the single bedroom, due to quick actions of initial attack crews. Structure and contents was approximately \$20,000 in damage. Seven occupants were displaced from the fire, Red Cross is assisting with housing until the home becomes habitable . No injuries to firefighters or civilians were reported.***

***County Fire responded with 3 #paramedic engine companies. 1 paramedic truck company, 1 brush patrol, 1 battalion chief and 1 fire investigator for a total of 16 personnel. The cause is currently under investigation by the Office of the Fire Marshal.***
