## Head-on crash involving city bus and truck on Phelan Road Monday morning

PHELAN, Calif. (VVNG.com) — A pick-up truck and a small city bus were involved in a head-on traffic collision in the community of Phelan early Monday morning.

It happened at about 7:30 am, on Phelan Road and Valle Vista and involved a white Ford F-350 and a small Victor Valley Transit Bus.

**San Bernardino County Fire** Spokesman Eric Sherwin said two patients were transported by ground ambulance to Loma Linda University Medical Center.

According to California Highway Patrol Officer Mike Mumford, the driver of the pickup received a broken femur and the transit bus driver sustained minor injuries.

"There were no passengers aboard the transit bus at the time of the collision," stated Mumford.

The cause of the accident is currently under investigation by the Victorville CHP station.

## Car fire along 15 Freeway in Cajon Pass quickly extinguished

CAJON PASS, Calif. (VVNG.com) — A car that caught fire in the Cajon Pass Saturday evening was quickly extinguished.

**San Bernardino County Fire Department** responded to the fire that was reported just after 6:30 p.m. on the northbound 15 Freeway at the Cleghorn offramp.

According to CHP logs, it was a black Lexus on the right shoulder with flames seen coming from the engine compartment.

The logs indicate that a Good Samaritan pulled over and attempted to put the fire out with an extinguisher.

Once fire personnel arrived, they were able to contain the fire to the vehicle and a small patch of vegetation.

No injuries were reported. The Cleghorn offramp from the NB 15 Freeway is closed at this time for an unknown duration.

## Yucca Valley hiker dies in park

JOSHUA TREE NATIONAL PARK — A 52-year-old Yucca Valley woman fell ill and, despite efforts to resuscitate her, died while hiking in the Black Rock area of Joshua Tree National Park on Thursday, April 11.

Susan Schoenfeldt was approximately one mile into the West Loop trail with her daughter at about 3 p.m. when she complained of nausea and being light-headed. She collapsed and her daughter called 911 and immediately administered CPR. **San Bernardino County Fire** paramedics were dispatched and took over efforts to resuscitate but were unable to revive the victim.

Schoenfeldt was pronounced dead at 4:58 and brought out by Joshua Tree National Park Search and Rescue members.
