Motorcyclist in critical condition after collision with truck at Seventh and Orange in Hesperia

HESPERIA — A motorcyclist was severely injured in a collision with a truck here Thursday evening.

The crash, which occurred at approximately 5 p.m., happened near the intersection of Seventh Avenue and Orange Street.

According to San Bernardino County Sheriff's Hesperia Station spokeswoman Jackie Chambers, the motorcycle was traveling south on Seventh Avenue when the truck, which was traveling north, attempted to make a left-hand turn onto Orange Street and collided with the motorcycle.

"When we arrived on scene, the motorcyclist was unconscious," Chambers said.

County Fire and emergency personnel attended to the motorcyclist, who was transported to a local hospital in critical condition, according to Chambers.

The Hesperia Sheriff's Station's Major Accident Investigation Team (MAIT) was requested to respond to the crash and the intersection was closed for hours while they processed the scene.
