RESIDENTIAL STRUCTURE FIRE HESPERIA, CA

Date/Time: **August 17, 2019 11:44 AM**
Location: **10100 Block of Shangrai-La Ave Hesperia, Ca**
Incident: **Residential Structure Fire**

Summary:

San Bernardino County Communication Center received a call from the resident of a home on the 10100 block of Shangrai-La Ave at 11:44 AM. Three engine companies, one truck company, one medic squad, one medic ambulance and a battalion chief were dispatched. A sheriff deputy arrived on scene to find the resident running in and out of the house then passing out on the front lawn. MT304 was the first fire unit on scene and reported flames and smoke coming from the fully involved garage with possible extension to the house from the attached garage. The next arriving unit began interior attack of the fire through the house into the garage and the truck company laddered the roof to start vertical ventilation. There was no fire damage inside the residence, but there was extensive smoke damage and one vehicle destroyed in the garage. Seven units from the San Bernardino County Fire Dept had knockdown on the fire in approximately 25 minutes.

One resident was transported from the scene to a local hospital for possible smoke inhalation. The American Red Cross was requested for housing and recovery support.
