## One person airlifted after rollover crash in Lucerne Valley

**LUCERNE VALLEY, Calif. (VVNG.com)** — One person was airlifted following a rollover crash in the town of Lucerne Valley Sunday night.

The single-vehicle rollover crash was reported at 8:07 pm, along State Route 18 across from the Mitsubishi Cement Plant.

Firefighters with **San Bernardino County Fire** arrived on scene and located a pickup truck on its side with one occupant trapped inside and requiring extrication.

County Fire Helicopter H325 was requested and landed at Pioneer Park to airlift the patient classified as “immediate”, scanner traffic reported.

According to CHP incident logs, SR-18 was closed in both directions for approximately 30 minutes while emergency personnel worked at the scene.

The cause of the crash is under investigation. No other injuries were reported as a result of the incident. Additional information will be updated as it becomes available.

## Woman who crashed vehicle on forest road near Lake Arrowhead is rescued

A 59-year-old Banning woman who was ejected from her vehicle in a rollover crash near Lake Arrowhead on Friday, Sept. 28, was hoisted to safety by a San Bernardino County sheriff’s helicopter.

Marvel Montgomery was found just after 1 p.m. outside her vehicle, which was on its side, on Forest Road 3N59, a sheriff’s news release said.

Because of the terrain, the helicopter landed about 100 yards away, and **San Bernardino County Fire** Department medics treated her. Montgomery was then placed in a rescue basket, and she and the medics were hoisted into the helicopter. Montgomery was flown to a hospital.

## San Bernardino County Firefighters battle house fire in Hesperia

HESPERIA, Calif. (VVNG.com) — **San Bernardino County Firefighters** responded to a house fire in the city of Hesperia Saturday morning.

It happened at about 10:15 am, on September 29, 2018, in the 17800 block of Deodar Street.

Firefighters arrived on scene and found fire through the roof of a single-story family residence and a working attic fire.

County Fire Spokesman Eric Sherwin said the call was dispatched as a first-alarm residential structure response which included 4 engines, a truck, an ambulance, and a chief officer.

Firefighters conducted a primary and secondary search of the residence and found no occupants inside.

According to Sherwin, they had one civilian with a complaint of smoke inhalation and that patient was treated and released at the scene. He declined medical transportation.

It took fire crews approximately 20 minutes to knock down the wind-fueled blaze.

No injuries were reported and the cause of the fire is under investigation.

## Victim airlifted after being shot multiple times in Adelanto

**ADELANTO, Calif. (VVNG.com)** — A man suffering from multiple gunshot wounds was airlifted to a trauma center early Saturday morning.

At about 5:19 am, Victor Valley Sheriff's Station Deputies and **San Bernardino County Firefighters** responded to the North Pointe Apartments in the 18300 block of Montezuma Street in Adelanto reference a shooting.

The victim is a Black male adult in his 40's and according to a witness who spoke on condition of anonymity, he an innocent bystander who was shot multiple times.

County Fire Spokesman Eric Sherwin told Victor Valley News when firefighters arrived on scene they treated the patient out in front of the apartment.

“The patient was flown via helicopter H325 to an out of area trauma center,” stated Sherwin. His condition as of Saturday night remains unknown.

Victor Valley News has reached out to Sheriff's Headquarters for additional information but did not receive any details into the incident.
