## Core One Labs Inc. Completes Construction of Water Main to Dispensary Property

VANCOUVER, British Columbia, Oct. 1, 2019 /PRNewswire/ -- Core One Labs Inc. (CSE: COOL), (OTCQX: LDSYD), (Frankfurt: LD6, WKN: A14XHT) ("Core One" or the "Company") announces that its wholly-owned subsidiary, LDS Development Corporation, has completed the construction of connecting into the City of Adelanto's water system and routing it to the property along with the completion of installation of a fire hydrant, as required by the **San Bernardino county fire** department.

Highway 395 dispensary construction plans are moving forward as intended. The Company's contractor was able to trench across Rancho Road for the necessary connection to the city water main just days ahead of the scheduled Rancho Road repaving project, saving tens of thousands of dollars of what would have been repaving cost to Core One. The required retaining wall around the dispensary property is the next project to commence. The steel has been ordered which will be part of completing the inner part of the wall and also will cover the materials needed for the dispensary building structure.

The 395 highway is currently being widened in order to help the flow of traffic getting up to high tourist ski resort locations like Mammoth Mountain and Lake Tahoe. The 395 highway already sees approximately 120,000 vehicles per day and the Highway 395 dispensary plans to capture a good amount of people traveling to ski destinations this coming season with its drive thru and in-store capabilities. The dispensary will be selling and delivering many popular cannabis brands, including CannaStrips™ and other anticipated products produced by Core One.

## One person killed in a rollover crash on I Avenue Sunday night in Hesperia

HESPERIA, Calif. (VVNG.com) — One person died in a single-vehicle rollover crash Sunday night.

It happened on September 29, 2019, at about 9:19 pm on I Avenue, just north of Buckthorn Avenue in Hesperia.

For reasons still unknown, an older model type SUV lost control and rolled several times before coming to a stop on its side.

Witnesses told VVNG the male driver was ejected and critically injured.

**San Bernardino County Firefighters** arrived on scene and requested a medical helicopter to airlift the patient. The request was subsequently canceled and the patient was rushed to a local hospital where he succumbed to his injuries.

The identity of the deceased is pending notification of next of kin and will be released by the San Bernardino County coroners office.

The cause of the accident is under investigation and anyone with information is asked to call the Hesperia sheriffs Station at 760-947-1500.

CAJON PASS, Calif. (VVNG.com) — Firefighters are battling a 1-acre brush fire on the northbound I-15 freeway in the cajon pass.

## **Firefighters battle fire in the Cajon Pass**

CAJON PASS — As afternoon commuters made their way through the Cajon Pass, firefighters battled a 10-acre vegetation fire with a moderate rate of spread

At 4:05 p.m. Monday, the **San Bernardino County Fire** District reported the 1-acre blaze, named the “Devore Fire,” was located near northbound Interstate 15 near Kenwood Boulevard and west of the Interstate 15/215 split.

At 5:06 p.m., the fire had grown to 10 acres, with Cal Fire, U.S. Forest Service and county firefighters battling the blaze. During that time, the No. 4 lane, shoulder, Kenwood off-ramp and truck bypass lanes were closed, according to the U.S. Forest Service.

A Facebook video posted near the start of the blaze showed the hillside on fire with plenty of smoke. A second video posted at approximately 5 p.m. showed fire personnel on the charred hillside, no fire and no smoke. The cause of the fire is unknown and under investigation.

## Apple Valley firefighters extricate man trapped in rollover crash Monday

APPLE VALLEY, Calif. (VVNG.com) — Firefighters with the Apple Valley Fire Protection District had to free a man from his wrecked vehicle Monday afternoon.

It happened at 4:30 p.m. on Rimrock Road, just east of Serrano Road on September 30, 2019.

Isaiah Fullington said he was on his way home when he witnessed the dramatic crash through his rearview mirror.

“It was a shadow almost, like it just went up, and after it went airborne I saw it landing and just start rolling,” Fullington said.

Apple Valley Fire Protection District’s Battalion Chief Buddy Peratt said they responded and found the vehicle on its side with the need for “extensive extrication.”

In addition to AMR and Apple Valley Police, Perratt said that a truck company, a rescue truck, and a battalion chief responded to the incident.

A woman who followed the vehicle from eastbound Highway 18 told authorities the man was driving fast and reckless just before the crash.

“Once the patient was extricated, he was taken to St. Mary’s Medical Center where he was flown by **San Bernardino County H325** to a trauma center down the hill,” stated Peratt.

Authorities shut down Rimrock Road near Serrano Road for an investigation. The man’s condition is unknown as of Monday evening.
