Copter crew rescues unconscious skier on Mount Baldy

A helicopter crew rescued a cross-country snow skier who fell in the Mount Baldy area on Tuesday, March 19.

The crew of 40King3 was dispatched to assist **San Bernardino County Fire** with the report of a cross-country snow skier who fell and was rendered unconscious. Initially, while trying to locate the skier, the crew of 40King3 experienced high winds and low clouds in the area.

Determined to locate the skier, the crew made a final attempt to access the area, this time approaching from the south side of Mount Baldy. During a break in the weather, the crew located the skier and called for assistance from Air Rescue 306 (AR306) to perform a hoist rescue of the victim.

AR306 responded to the area and was guided to the location of the victim by 40king3. Once onscene, Firefighter Sherwin was lowered to the victim to assess her injuries. Once stabilized, the victim was placed into a rescue harness, hoisted into AR306 and transported to an awaiting ambulance.

While performing the hoist, the crew of AR306 battled darkness, extremely high winds and the threat of incoming cloud coverage. The hoist was performed while using Night Vision Goggles.

A deputy-involved shooting took place in the western unincorporated area of Fontana on the morning of Wednesday, March 20, according to the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department.

Deputies from the Specialized Enforcement Division were conducting surveillance on a residence in the 15000 block of Ceres Avenue for a suspect who had an arrest warrant for armed robbery, the Sheriff's Department said on Twitter.

When deputies attempted to make contact with the suspect, a deputy-involved shooting occurred, the Sheriff's Department said.

The unidentified suspect was transported to a local area hospital with unknown injuries.

Specialized Investigations detectives went to the scene to conduct the investigation.

No additional information was immediately available. The Sheriff's Department will be issuing a press release later.
