NEEDLES — The community of Santa's helpers that hope to provide local children in need with a brighter Christmas have a short deadline this year: Monday, Dec. 17 is the last day for filling Needles Spark of Love toy drive donation boxes in various locations around the city.

Said Tena McGee, who's organizing the efforts under the auspices of the Women's Club of Needles: "Please. We've over 220 children and we need the community's help. Please drop off the toys at any of your nearest Needles' businesses."

Those who want to adopt a family or adopt a child can call McGee at 760-985-4050.

Boxes can be found at city hall, the library, Big O Tires-NAPA Auto Parts, the Calizona RV Park, Desert Hair and Nails Designs, Desert Communities Federal Credit Union, Needles High School, Needles Chamber of Commerce, 50 Shades Salon, Dollar General and Rite Aid.

Boxes are collected by volunteers from Needles' **San Bernardino County Fire** Department Station 32 who also help with distribution.

McGee said she also wanted to thank Laughlin's Aquarius Casino Resort which teams with the Women's Club for the annual Feed a Family program for which 90 families have signed up; and Arrowhead Credit Union for their support.

What should donors put in the boxes?

Only new, unwrapped toys are accepted. McGee's helpers compiled a list of children's requests as recipients, from ages 0 to 18, were signed up during the Holiday Fun Fair. They include Play Station games, Noisy Toys, dinosaurs, baby dolls, Minecraft toys, Paw Patrol characters, bikes, basketballs (and all other sort of balls as

well, McGee added), unicorns, Barbie dolls, Shopkins, art supplies, nerf guns, remote control cars, Doc McStuffins, tents, superheroes and blocks.

Units respond to traffic collision on Highway 38

One person is injured, another is reportedly missing after an SUV overturned 5 miles east of Angelus Oaks on Highway 38 Wednesday, Dec. 12.

Units from **San Bernardino County Fire** and Big Bear Fire Authority responded to the incident, which occurred around 3 p.m. According to a California Highway Patrol report, the reporting party stated that several dogs were also in the vehicle and at least one of the dogs got out of the vehicle.

An unidentified female driver was bleeding from her head. Some of the dogs in the vehicle are also injured. The female told CHP officers that she had a male passenger with her who was no longer in the vehicle. She isn't sure if he walked away or was thrown from the vehicle.

As of 3:36 p.m. the upbound lanes and partial downbound lanes were blocked by the vehicle, which is on its roof. Big Bear Tow was enroute to the scene.
