## 1 wounded in San Bernardino shooting; 1 suspect shot by police after chase

San Bernardino police chasing three people who fled the scene of a shooting Wednesday afternoon shot one of them when he got out of the vehicle holding a handgun, according to a police spokeswoman.

Both the victim of the initial shooting and the man shot by police were expected to survive, said San Bernardino Police Department spokeswoman Sadie Albers. No police were injured during the incident.

Just after 4 p.m., police and paramedics were called to the Eureka Manor Apartments in the 1500 block of East Eureka Street, where an adult male had been shot and wounded, according to Albers and **San Bernardino County Fire** Department spokesman Ryan Vaccaro.

Police chased after the three people seen fleeing. The pursuit ended about 4 miles away at 20th Street and Reedy Avenue, a residential area near the 210/330 freeway interchange.

One of the suspects jumped out of the vehicle holding a gun, Albers said, and an officer shot him.

That suspect, a male in his 30s, was taken to a hospital with non-life-threatening injuries. The other two people in the vehicle were taken into custody, Albers said.

With the investigation continuing into the night Wednesday, no other information was available, including the suspects' names.

In the original shooting at the apartment complex, Vaccaro said the Fire Department had received a report that the victim was a child. But Albers said that was a miscommunication; no child was wounded, but a child did witness the shooting.
