VICTORVILLE, Calif. (VVNG.com) A motorcycle rider was airlifted to an-out-of-area trauma center here Monday afternoon in Victorville following a crash.

According to CHP logs, the solo-motorcycle accident was reported on Yates Road near Tahoe Road at about 5:25 p.m. in the jurisdiction of Spring Valley Lake.

The rider was traveling westbound on Yates Road when, for reasons still under investigation, the bike left the roadway and crashed into a barbed wire fence and landed down an embankment belonging to the Mojave Narrows Regional Park.

"The rider was ejected from the motorcycle, he flew a little distance from the bike, and CHP helicopter H82 flew the solo rider out to Loma Linda University Medical Center," **San Bernardino County Fire** Spokesman Eric Sherwin said.

The identity and condition of the rider is unknown at this time. The cause of the crash is being investigated by the California Highway Patrol – Victorville Station.
