Ontario police motorcycle officer recovering after crash on 215 Freeway in Grand Terrace

GRAND TERRACE, Calif. (KABC) -- An Ontario police motorcycle officer was recovering after being airlifted to a hospital Tuesday following a crash on the 215 Freeway in Grand Terrace, authorities said.

Police said later Tuesday that the officer was walking and talking and his injuries were considered not life-threatening.

The crash happened shortly after 3 p.m. on the southbound side of the freeway, near Barton Road, according to the **San Bernardino County Fire** Department. Whether any vehicles besides the motorcycle were involved was unclear.

All southbound lanes except one were closed while crews worked to clear the scene.

The cause of the crash is under investigation.

Missing woman found

Marian Nyirankulikiyinka is missing, and Highland Police Department asks that anyone with information on her whereabouts contact the station.

At approximately 10 a.m. on Tuesday, Oct. 22, a passerby in the area of Base Line and Pennsylvania in San Bernardino saw Nyirankulikiyinka and reported her location to San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department dispatch.

San Bernardino County Fire personnel along with personnel from AMR responded to the location. Marian was transported to a local area hospital for treatment of minor injuries and has been reunited with her family.

The San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department thanks everyone who assisted in the search for Nyirankulikiyinka. A special Thank you to the citizen that called in her location and alerted emergency medical personnel.

Highland sheriff's deputies are asking for public's assistance in locating Marian Nyirankulikiyinka, a 76-year-old woman who has been missing since Monday, Oct. 21.

According to a sheriff's department press release, Nyirankulikiyinka was last seen at approximately 7:30 p.m. on Monday at Highland Community Park, 7793 Central Ave., near her Crestview Lane residence.

She suffers from Alzheimer's, high blood pressure, diabetes and high cholesterol.

A missing person report was made at approximately 10:39 p.m. and sheriff's department conducted an extensive search through the night with the assistance of Sheriff's Aviation and a Victorville City K9 unit.

The search continues into Tuesday morning, and the Highland Police Department asks that anyone with information regarding Nyirankulikiyinka's whereabouts contact the station by calling (909) 425-9793 or sheriff's dispatch at (909) 387-8313.

One person airlifted from Highway 395 crash in Adelanto

ADELANTO, Calif. (VVNG.com) — One person was airlifted and several others were injured following a crash on US Highway 395 Tuesday afternoon in Adelanto.

It happened at about 4:22 pm, on October 22, 2019, on US-395, south of Air Expressway and involved two vehicles.

Authorities arrived to the incident and found a black 2016 Infiniti Q6 on its roof and a black 2015 Jeep Grand Cherokee stopped in the northbound lane.

San Bernardino County Firefighters requested a medical helicopter to airlift one patient to Arrowhead Regional Medical Center.

North and southbound traffic on the highway was halted for approximately 45 minutes as authorities investigated and worked to clear up the scene.
