> Two men die in Sunday crash

Two men die in Sunday crash

Two men were killed Sunday in a crash off Interstate 15 near Halloran Summit Road, according to the California Highway Patrol.

The two men — a 23-year-old from Las Vegas and a 29-year-old from Fontana — have not been identified. They were passengers in a 2005 Chevrolet Silverado truck traveling north on I-15 north of Halloran Summit Road about 11:40 p.m. when the driver, a 25-year-old woman from Las Vegas, allowed the truck to enter the dirt center divider of the roadway, the CHP said.

When the driver turned to the right in an attempt to pull the vehicle back onto the roadway, the vehicle overturned several times, the CHP reported. The Silverado came to rest on its roof in the center divider, facing northeast.

The two men suffered major injuries and were pronounced dead at the scene by medical personnel responding to the crash. **San Bernardino County Fire** responders took the driver and a 20-year-old femal passenger to University Medical Center in Las Vegas, where they were treated for neck and back injuries.

The CHP said alcohol and drugs are not believed to be a contributing factor in the crash, which is being investigated by the California Highway Patrol, Barstow Area. Anyone with additional information regarding the crash is asked to contact the CHP at 760-255-5900.
