

TWO INJURED IN HEAD-ON COLLISION IN JOHNSON VALLEY

Two men were seriously injured following a head on crash in Johnson Valley Thursday afternoon. **County Fire** Battalion Chief Mike McClintock said firefighters from Yucca Valley and Yucca Mesa—as well as the California Highway Patrol and Morongo Basin Ambulance—were called at 4:44 p.m. to Old Woman Springs Road near Olivine Road for a head-one collision.

Paramedics found one man in a gray 4-door car who needed to be extricated using the Jaws of life; the man in a blue Ford F-150 pick-up truck had gotten out on his own prior to the arrival of first responders. One man was flown by Mercy Air to Desert Hospital in Palm Springs; the other man was taken by MBA to Desert. The California Highway Patrol is investigating.

Person dies in vehicle collision in southern Fontana on May 16 Staff Writer, Fontana Herald News Posted: May 17, 2019

A person died in a two-vehicle collision in southern Fontana on May 16, according to the Fontana Police Department.

The incident occurred on Sierra Avenue near the southern border of Fontana at the Riverside County line, and the Riverside County Sheriff's Department initially responded to the location.

One person was trapped in a vehicle and was extricated by the **San Bernardino County Fire** Department, and another person had no pulse when first responders arrived, according to initial reports.

Sierra was closed for several hours but reopened shortly after 6:30 p.m. The investigation is ongoing by the Fontana P.D.'s Major Accident Investigation Team.

No other details were immediately available.
