County Firefighters Respond to Double Wide Mobile Home Fire in Hesperia

Date/Time: Thursday, June 11, 2020, 12:08 pm
Location: 11K block Locust Ave, Hesperia CA
Incident: Residential Structure Fire 20-125578

Summary: Shortly after noon today, San Bernardino County Fire responded to multiple reports of a fire to the rear of a home at the 11k block of Hawthorne in the City of Hesperia. Battalion 120 along with company 304 arrived shortly after dispatch to find a fully involved double wide trailer to the rear of a single-story home. As firefighters made access, they found multiple cars as well as Conex storage units immediately threatened by the fire. Lines were put into place to protect these exposures as well as limit the fires spread into any brush or homes. Ultimately the mobile home, as well as two vehicles, sustained a total loss. The fire also spread to the Conex storage containers which impacted the property inside. The primary and secondary searches were all clear. Knockdown of the fire was achieved in approximately 20 minutes. Due to resource commitments on the incident cover engines were brought up to maintain service from Fontana and Devore.

No injuries to civilians or firefighters were reported. Three engines, one truck company, one chief officer, one medic ambulance, one investigator, and one medic squad totaling 18 personnel from County Fire were assigned to the incident. The cause remains under investigation by the office of the Fire Marshal.
