Three people are injured in collision involving three vehicles in Fontana on March 24

Three people were injured in a traffic collision involving three vehicles in Fontana on March 24.

At about 9:35 p.m., the Fontana Police Department and the **San Bernardino County Fire** Department responded to the incident, which occurred in the 17200 block of Foothill Boulevard.

Police are investigating what caused the driver of a white Plymouth Caravan traveling westbound on Foothill to hit and jump the center divider and then collide with two vehicles traveling in the eastbound lanes of Foothill.

According to a Fontana P.D. officer, the driver of a gray Honda Accord hit the Caravan after it jumped the divider and continued into the eastbound lanes of Foothill. The driver of a gray Chevy Silverado pickup rear ended the Accord.

Emergency medical responders treated three people with non-life-threatening injuries and they were transported to a local hospital.

The Fontana P.D. is investigating the accident.

Witness helps chase down hit-and-run driver involving a motorcycle in Victorville

VICTORVILLE, Calif. (VVNG.com) – A witness who saw a car with major damage fleeing a crash followed the driver for several miles until the suspect crashed a second time and became trapped in his vehicle.

San Bernardino County Fire and the Victorville Police Department responded to a hit-and-run crash that was reported at 7:08 p.m. at the intersection of Bear Valley Road and Stonegate Drive, just west of Amethyst Road in the city of Victorville.

Emergency crews located a 35-year-old male motorcycle rider on the ground suffering from major life-threatening injuries.

The severely injured rider was unconscious but breathing, Ivettee Cifuentes told Victor Valley News, she stopped to render aid to the victim, along with other Good Samaritans.

"I took his wallet out to find out his name, I kept calling him by his name the whole time. I'm so heart broken over this tragedy, for him and his family," Cifuentes said about the rider.

Firefighters requested County Helicopter H325 to land on Bear Valley Road and subsequently airlift the male to Antelope Valley Hospital for further treatment.

According to Deputy Vogel with the Victorville PD, a witness who saw the vehicle with major damage followed the silver 2017 Nissan Maxima to the area of Monte Vista And Maricopa Roads where the suspect crashed into a tree while trying to maneuver a left turn onto Monte Vista Road.

The suspect was trapped in the vehicle until deputies were able to get him out and detain him. He sustained only minor injuries.

Police say he faces several charges, including felony hit-and-run and suspicion of driving under the influence of drugs and or alcohol.

Westbound Bear Valley Road at Stonegate Drive was closed for an investigation, as well as the intersection where the suspect crashed.

Officials did not have an update on the motorcycle rider's condition as of late Saturday night.

Driver airlifted after crashing into the back of a semi on I-15 freeway

BARSTOW, Calif. (VVNG.com) — One person was airlifted after their vehicle crashed into the back of a semi on the I-15 freeway early Saturday.

At about 4:00 am, **San Bernardino County Firefighters** were dispatched to a crash on the northbound I-15, north of the Stoddard Wells Road exit near mile marker 63.

According to the California Highway Patrol incident logs, the driver of the semi reported a vehicle collided into the back of his semi on the right-hand shoulder.

Firefighters arrived and found a white sedan with major damage and requested a medical helicopter to respond to the scene.
The I-15 was briefly shut down while the helicopter landed just north of the accident on the freeway.
One person was airlifted to Arrowhead Regional Medical Center with life-threatening injuries.
All lanes were re-opened by 5:46 am.
The cause of the crash is under investigation by the California Highway Patrol.
