San Bernardino Fire Station 225 Temporarily Closed

Fire Station 225 located at 1640 West Kendall Dr. in San Bernardino has temporarily been shut down for repairs. Firefighters have been serving their community from a modular building at this location since 1976. This station serves Cal State San Bernardino and the surrounding community.

We anticipate minimal changes in response times. The community will be served by three nearby San Bernardino County fire stations.

The 3 person crew, which operates a Type 1 Fire Engine, a Medic Engine and a Brush Engine, has temporarily relocated to Fire Station 221, located at 200 East 3rd St., San Bernardino.

As call volume for fire and EMS services continue to rise in this area, the need for a fire station remains. San Bernardino County Fire is dedicated to mitigating the much needed repairs as quickly as possible so that the station may reopen in the near future.
