## Motorcyclist, 24, critically injured in Sunday night crash in Victorville

VICTORVILLE, Calif. (VVNG.com) A 24-year-old motorcyclist from Victorville was rushed to a trauma center with life-threatening injuries following a crash Sunday night.

The accident involving an early model Honda and a motorcycle was reported just before 8:30 p.m., September 24, on Amethyst Road north of Bear Valley Road at the entrance of the Rite Aid shopping center.

When Victorville Sheriff's Deputies and **San Bernardino County Firefighters** arrived they located the man lying on the ground with shallow breaths, scanner traffic reported.

According to witness, Christopher Rich, "[the] rider had heavy bleeding out of both ears, broken leg and throwing up blood after he woke up from being knocked out. He tried getting up but everyone kept him still". The rider was taken to Desert Valley Hospital by ambulance and later airlifted to Loma Linda University Medical Center. As of 10:00 p.m., his condition remains unknown.

Based on witness statements at the scene, the motorcyclist was traveling northbound on Amethyst Road when he collided into the passenger side of a Honda that was making a left turn into the Rite Aid shopping center from southbound Amethyst.

The official cause of the crash remains under investigation by the Victorville Sheriff's Station. Information will be updated as it becomes available.

## Young girl hit by car in Victorville Wal-Mart parking lot; driver flees

VICTORVILLE, Calif. (VVNG.com) Police are searching for a vehicle that struck a young-girl in a busy Wal-Mart parking lot and fled Sunday afternoon.

Just after 2:00 p.m., deputies responded to Victorville Wal-Mart (west) at 12234 Palmdale Road reference a vehicle versus a pedestrian.

When deputies arrived, they located a small girl about five years of age that had been hit by a vehicle.

According to witnesses, a white newer model Toyota Corolla with 'Riverside Car Sales' paper plates left the scene after hitting a little girl. Per scanner reports, witnesses obtained photos of the suspect vehicle driven by a Hispanic male adult.

Paramedics and fire personnel treated the child at the scene for minor injuries and was not transported for further treatment.

## 1 rescued, critically hurt after former Alberto's in San Bernardino burns

One person was taken to the hospital in critical condition on Friday, Sept. 22, after a fire broke out at an abandoned commercial structure in San Bernardino, fire officials said.

The fire was reported about 2 p.m. in the 2300 block of North Del Rosa Avenue in San Bernardino in what used to be an Alberto's restaurant, said **San Bernardino County Fire Department** Capt. Steve Tracy.

Firefighters arrived and found heavy smoke coming from the building and also learned there was someone inside who was trapped, Tracy said.

They went in and rescued the person, who was taken to a hospital by ambulance with critical injuries.

The fire was contained about 2:47 p.m., but crews were still on scene doing "mop up" about 3 p.m., Tracy said.

## Body found in California Aqueduct near Hesperia, sheriff investigating

A body was found in the California Aqueduct south of Hesperia on Thursday afternoon, Sept. 21, and San Bernardino County Sheriff-Coroner's officials will investigate the death, according to a written statement from the department

Initially, **San Bernardino County Fire Department** firefighters were dispatched to the 16000 block of Highway 173 around 2:40 p.m. after reports that a body had been found near the Mojave Siphon Power Plant, Eric Sherwin, county fire spokesman, confirmed by phone.

A sheriff's statement described the location as between Cedar Springs Dam Road and Arrowhead Lake Road. Sherwin described how this is the last section where the aqueduct is above ground before the water is carried via underground tunnels, where it is pumped up into Silverwood Lake.

The sheriff's dive team was called out to retrieve the body. The sheriff-coroner's investigation will aim to identify the victim and determine how and why the person got into the aqueduct, according to the sheriff's statement.
