San Bernardino HHW Collection Facility Re-Opening with COVID-19 Safety Precautions

To help communities dispose of their Household Hazardous Waste during the COVID-19 crisis, the San Bernardino Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) collection facility will reopen to the public on Monday, May 4th. The HHW collection facility hours of operation are Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Extra precautions and restrictions are being implemented to protect residents and staff from COVID-19 when collecting HHW from participants. Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generators (CESQG) appointments will be scheduled during business hours. The material re-use store will remain closed to the public until further notice.

Additionally, the following Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) locations will be open to the public as follows:

- The City of Rialto will continue their HHW services to the public every 2nd and 4th Friday and Saturday of the month from 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. Next opening is May 8^{th} .
- The City of Upland will open their HHW site to the public every Saturday from 9:00 a.m. 2:00 p.m. beginning May 16th.
- All other HHW locations will remain closed until further notice.

Residents who are displaying or experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms, will be turned away and asked to return to the HHW collection site 2 weeks after symptoms subside. Residents who are unable to bring in their HHW during these times are asked to safely store their items at their homes until the situation improves.
