Vegetation Fire in Lake Arrowhead on Torrey Road

The Torrey Fire is 100% contained. The fire was held at 1 acre.

The lead agency on the fire was CalFire with U.S. Forest Service and **San Bernardino County Fire**. Crews will remain on scene overnight and tomorrow.

The cause of the fire is under investigation.

According to the CHP the fire is now out, but units will remain on scene.

Lake Arrowhead, CA – Vegetation fire was reported from Keller Peak at 3:50 on Monday, November 13. The Fire is on Torrey Road in Lake Arrowhead. Units dispatched reported smoke showing. Lake Arrowhead units on scene reported a 100 x 100 spot, moving up hill towards McKay park.

CalFire has aircraft enroute. Units have set up at the top of the hill. They have a good defensive position if the fire makes it to the crest of the hill.

Dozer and aircraft have been cancelled. Firefighters are making good progress on the fire. Will update as more information becomes available

Security guard dies when struck by vehicle at FedEx facility in Bloomington

A security guard working at the FedEx distribution center in Bloomington was killed Friday, Nov. 10, when he was struck by a vehicle.

Cal/OSHA is investigating the fatality, said California Department of Industrial Relations spokesman Frank Polizzi. No other details on the circumstances of the incident were available.

The victim was an employee of Allied Universal, Polizzi said, which provides security, janitorial and staffing services.

“We extend our deepest condolences to the family and friends of the individual involved in this accident. Safety is our highest priority and we are cooperating fully with investigating authorities at this time,” said FedEx spokeswoman Meredith Miller.

About 1:30 p.m. Friday, firefighters responded to a report of CPR in progress at FedEx at 330 W. Resource Drive, **San Bernardino County Fire Department** spokesman Eric Sherwin said Monday. A person suffered fatal injuries there, Sherwin said.

He referred other questions to the Rialto police and fire departments, which could not be reached for comment Monday.
