Man dies in hit-and-run collision in San Bernardino on May 20

Man dies in hit-and-run collision in San Bernardino on May 20

A man died in a hit-and-run incident in San Bernardino on May 20, according to the San Bernardino Police Department.

On May 20 at about 11 p.m., officers from the San Bernardino Police Department's Patrol Division were dispatched to the 500 block of East Central Avenue to assist **San Bernardino County Fire** Department personnel regarding a suspicious death. Fire Department personnel located the victim and transported him to a local hospital, where he was pronounced deceased.

When officers arrived on scene, they located evidence indicating the victim had been struck by a vehicle at this location. Traffic investigators were called in to assist and determined that the victim was likely walking eastbound along the south side of the roadway when he was struck by a passing vehicle. Because the involved driver was not located at the scene, this is being investigated as a hit-and-run collision.

The victim was identified as a 37-year-old resident of San Bernardino. His identity is being withheld pending notification to next of kin.
