Blue Cut Fire Community Meeting Set for Sept. 20

Hosted by the Wrightwood Fire Safe Council, residents affected by the Blue Cut Fire are invited to a community meeting on Sept. 20 at 7 p.m. in the Wrightwood Elementary School Auditorium.

The Blue Cut Fire started Tuesday, Aug. 16 and burned over 36,000 acres prompting evacuations in Lytle Creek, Wrightwood, West Cajon Valley, Summit Valley, Baldy Mesa, Phelan, Pinon Hills, and Oak Hills. Railroad lines, local roads, State Route 138, and Interstate 15 were closed during the course of the fire fight.

Representatives from the San Bernardino County Fire & Sheriff Departments, U.S. Forest Service, CAL FIRE, and Southern California Edison will provide an overview of the fire, address post-fire impacts to the community, and answer questions.

Wrightwood Elementary School is located at 1175 Highway 2 in Wrightwood.
