A defensible home is one that has the greatest potential for surviving a wildfire. Specifically, defensible space around a home is the required space between a structure and the trees, shrubs and plants in the area that, under normal conditions, creates a sufficient buffer to slow or halt the spread of wildfire to a structure.
