1 person critically injured in early morning crash in Hesperia

HESPERIA, Calif. (VVNG.com) — A two-vehicle crash early Wednesday morning in Hesperia left one person critically injured.

It happened at about 7:35 am, in the 8400 block of Eleventh Avenue near Joshua Street in Hesperia.

The crash involved a white pickup truck and a silver Ford Mustang that went through a fence and into someone's front yard.

San Bernardino County Fire responded to the incident and located both vehicles with major damage and one occupant requiring extrication.

County fire public information officer Jeremy Kern told Victor Valley News one adult male was extricated and flown to a trauma center. An occupant of the truck was transported by ground ambulance to a local hospital with less serious injuries.

Helicopter Mercy 22 landed at the Hesperia Airport and the male was flown to Arrowhead Regional Medical Center.

The cause of the accident is currently under investigation by the Hesperia Sheriff's Station.

VICTORVILLE, Calif. (VVNG.com) — A 16-year-old was arrested for attempted murder after he allegedly stabbed his stepdad multiple times.

It happened on Monday, March 18, 2019, in the 17000 block of Lorene Drive in Victorville.

Sheriff's spokeswoman Mara Rodriguez told Victor Valley News the suspect and his49-year-old step-father were involved in an argument.

"The argument became physical and the suspect took a knife from his pocket and began stabbing the victim multiple times," stated Rodriguez.

According to Rodriguez, the suspect ran from the location but was apprehended nearby by deputies. He was arrested and booked at the High Desert Juvenile Detention Center for attempted murder.

The victim was airlifted to a nearby trauma center for his injuries. His condition is not known at this time.

Victorville Man Arrested for Allegedly Setting His Rental Home on Fire

VICTORVILLE, Calif. – A Victorville man was arrested for intentionally setting the home that he rents on fire last week.

On Wednesday, March 13, 2019, at around 4:50 p.m. Victorville deputies and **San Bernardino County Fire** Department firefighters responded to a kitchen fire in the 17000 block of Jurassic Place in Victorville. Through investigation, it was learned that the renter, Tom Caballero, 36, lit the kitchen on fire using an unknown accelerant.

"He intentionally remained in the house as the fire began to spread," said Victorville Sheriff's Department Spokeswoman Mara Rodriguez. "Deputies arrived on scene and pulled Caballero out of the house to safety." He was taken to the hospital for treatment of injuries and was then booked at the West Valley Detention Center for Arson of an inhabited structure.

No charges have been filed by the San Bernardino District Attorney's office at this time, as a result, Caballero was released on March 15, 2019. No court dates are scheduled at this time.
