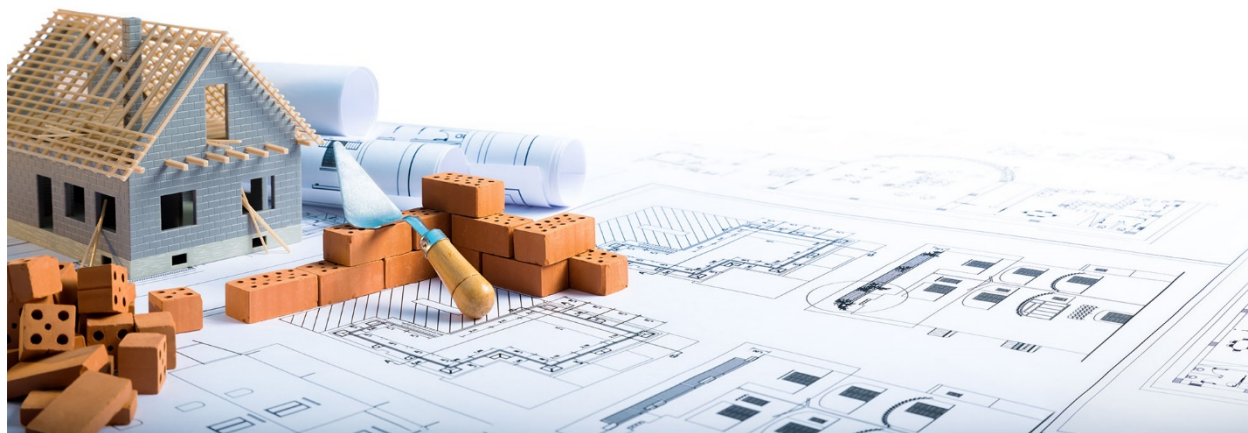


## San Bernardino County

### Interested Parties for Homeless and Affordable Housing Developments Survey



The San Bernardino County Community Development and Housing Department (CDH) is the lead County agency for various state and federal funds which are intended for the development of affordable housing units and/or create of housing units for persons experiencing homelessness. It is the intent of CDH to work collaboratively with myriad of partners to develop competitive project applications to secure state and federal funding necessary for the creation of new housing units for our most vulnerable populations throughout San Bernardino County.

As part of this effort, the County is creating an Interested Parties List to be used by CDH to facilitate the dissemination of information regarding upcoming partnership opportunities to work with partners to submit competitive applications in response to state and federal Notices of Funding Availability (NOFA) or Request for Proposals or Interest (RFP/I) (i.e. Homekey, No Place Like Home).

To be added to this Interested Parties List, complete the questions below and participate in a future consultation meeting with CDH staff. Upon submittal of the required information, you will receive an e-mail confirming placement on the Interested Parties List. Also within seven business days, you will receive an email outlining some of the information and questions the County will be seeking in its first consultation call, with a proposed scheduled call in the email. Failure to update your information when requested by CDH staff may result in removal from the Interested Parties List.

PLEASE NOTE: Placement on the Interested Parties List does not guarantee that CDH will partner with your agency on any future funding applications, nor does it guarantee that the County will provide any funding associated with the applications. It will commence conversations regarding your proposed project concept, receive information when the state or federal government issue notices of funding availability or request for proposals or when the County solicits affordable housing proposals.
