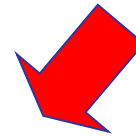

**NOTICE OF INCREASE IN
STATE FISH AND WILDLIFE FEES
EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2022**

With the passage of Senate Bill 1535, State Fish and Game Code Section 713 authorizes an annual adjustment to the State fees for the filing of Notices of Determination and Notices of Exemption. The fees for 2022 are as follows:

CEQA Document	Fish & Wildlife Filing Fee	Clerk of the Board Fee	Total Fee	Required Documentation
Notice of Exemption	N/A	\$50.00	\$50.00	N/A
Notice of Determination for Negative Declaration or Mitigated Negative Declaration that does not affect species or their habitat. Must contact Fish and Wildlife for documentation confirming “No Effect” on fish and wildlife. (<i>De Minimis Finding no longer accepted.</i>)	\$0	\$50.00	\$50.00	Must File Documentation stating “ <u>No Effect</u> ” on Fish and Wildlife
Notice of Determination for Negative Declaration or Mitigated Negative Declaration that may affect fish and wildlife. Fish and Wildlife review needed.	\$2,548.00	\$50.00	\$2,598.00	N/A
Notice of Determination with Environmental Impact Report. Fish and Wildlife review needed.	\$3,539.25	\$50.00	\$3,589.25	N/A
