SMH SUD	02	Telehealth	02	Telehealth Not In Client's Home (Telehealth provided other than in patient's home)	The location where service and health related services are provided or received, through telecommunication technology. Patient is not located in their home when receiving health services or health related services through telecommunication technology.
SMH	03	School	03	School	A facility whose primary purpose is education.
SMH SUD	29	Homeless	04	Homeless Shelter	A facility or location whose primary purpose is to provide temporary housing to homeless individuals (e.g., emergency shelters, individual or family shelters).
SMH	09	Jail	09	Jail (Prison/Correctional Facility)	A prison, jail, reformatory, work farm, detention center, or any other similar facility maintained by either Federal, State, or local authorities for the purpose of confinement or rehabilitation of adult or juvenile criminal offenders. (Note: Place of service code cannot be coded until the jail-involved initiative is implemented).

Patient is located in their home (which is a location other than a hospital or other facility where the patient receives care in a private residence) when receiving health services or health related services through telecommunication technology.
SMH SUD	11	DBH Site	11	DBH/Contractor Site - Office	Location, other than a hospital, skilled nursing facility (SNF), military treatment facility, community health center, State or local public health clinic, or intermediate care facility (ICF), where the health professional routinely provides health examinations, diagnosis and treatment of illness or injury on an ambulatory basis.
SMH SUD	12	Home	12	Home	Location, other than a hospital or other facility, where the patient receives care in a private residence.
SMH	13	Age Specific Community Center	Eliminated with the implementation of CalAIM		
SMH SUD	Did not exist prior to CalAIM		14	Group Home	A residence with shared living areas, where clients receive supervision and other services such as social and/or behavioral services, custodial services, and minimal services (e.g., medication administration).
SMH SUD	15	Mobile Service	15	Mobile Unit	A facility/unit that moves from place to place equipped to provide preventive screening, diagnostic, and/or treatment services. (Note: this is only for use with CCRT, Inn Roads and SUDRS MAT).
SMH SUD	16	Non-Traditional Service Location	16	Temporary Lodging	A short-term accommodation such as a hotel, camp ground, hostel, cruise ship or resort where the patient receives care and which is not identified by any other Place of Service code.

SMH	20	Urgent Care	20	Urgent Care Facility	Location, distinct from a hospital emergency room, an office or a clinic, whose purpose is to diagnose and treat illness or injury for unscheduled, ambulatory patients seeking immediate medical attention.
SMH	21	Inpatient	Eliminated with the implementation of CalAIM (Note: ARMC is to use 51 instead of 21).		
SMH	23	Emergency Room	23	Emergency Room - Hospital	A portion of a hospital where emergency diagnosis and treatment of illness or injury is provided.
SMH SUD	27	Field/OOC	27	Outreach Site/Street	A non-permanent location on the street or found environment, not described by any other POS code, where health professionals provide preventive, screening, diagnostic, and/or treatment services to unsheltered homeless individuals. (Note: This differs from previous Pre-CalAIM definition and is specific to services provided to unsheltered homeless individuals).

SMH	30	Faith based- Church, Temple, etc.	Eliminated with the implementation of CalAIM		
SMH	Did not exist prior to CalAIM		31	Skilled Nursing Facility	A facility which primarily provides inpatient skilled nursing care and related services to patients who require medical, nursing or rehabilitative services but does not provide the level of care or treatment available in a hospital.
SUD	33	Licensed Care Residential Adult	33	Custodial Care Facility	A facility that provides room, board, and other personal assistance services, generally on a long-term basis, and which does not include a medical component.
SMH	Did not exist prior to CalAIM		51	Inpatient Psychiatric Facility	A facility that provides inpatient psychiatric services for the diagnosis and treatment of mental illness on a 24-hour basis, by or under the supervision of a physician.
SMH	Did not exist prior to CalAIM		52	Psych Facility-Partial Hospitalization	A facility for the diagnosis and treatment of mental illness that provides a planned therapeutic program for patients who do not require full time hospitalization, but who need broader programs than are possible from outpatient visits to a hospital-based or hospital-affiliated facility.
SMH	53	Other Community Location	53	Community Mental Health Center	DBH will not use 53 due to no applicable site (licensed outpatient for discharge inpatient clients).
SMH SUD	55	Residential Care/Community Location	55	Residential Care/Comm Treatment Fac (Residential Substance Abuse Treatment Facility)	A facility which provides treatment for substance (alcohol and drug) abuse to live-in residents who do not require acute medical care. Services include individual and group therapy and counseling, family counseling, laboratory tests, drugs and supplies, psychological testing, and room and board.

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SMH	Did not exist prior to CalAIM		56	Psychi Res Tx Center (Psychiatric Residential Treatment Center)	A facility or a distinct part of a facility for psychiatric care which provides a total 24-hour therapeutically planned and professionally staffed group living and learning environment.
SMH SUD	Did not exist prior to CalAIM		57	Non-Res SA Tx Facility (Non-residential Opioid Treatment Facility)	A location which provides treatment for substance (alcohol and drug) abuse on an ambulatory basis. Services include individual and group therapy and counseling, family counseling, laboratory tests, drugs and supplies, and psychological testing.
SMH SUD	Did not exist prior to CalAIM		58	Non-Res Opioid Tx Facility (Non-residential Opioid Treatment Facility)	A location that provides treatment for opioid use disorder on an ambulatory basis. Services include methadone and other forms of Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT).
SMH	72	Satellite	72	Rural Health Clinic	DBH will not use 72 due to no applicable site (rural primary care site).
