

GUIDELINES FOR ALLOWING PETS INTO DINING AREAS

PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED INSIDE A FOOD FACILITY unless the animal is:

- A service animal*, or
- A dog under the control of a uniformed law enforcement officer.

PET DOGS MAY BE ALLOWED INTO AN OUTDOOR DINING AREA only if:

- The owner of the food facility allows it.
- A separate outdoor entrance is present (the pet dog is not allowed to enter through the food facility).
- The pet dog is on a leash or confined to a pet carrier and is under the control of the dog owner.

Note:

- Pet owners are liable for any damage done to the premises or facilities by the dog.
- Pet dogs are not allowed on chairs, benches, seats, counter tops, or other fixtures.
