- IV. Legislation Update. Per John Davis, AB323 eliminating green waste/permission to use green waste as alternative cover in landfills. AB744/AB1001

Bottle Bill, SB405 Plastic Bag Bill, AB1021 Tax Credits, AB1022 CRT Funding, AB513 Tire funding SB529 Polystyrene Ban, and AB254 Mattress Recycling Bill.

- VI. Strategic Planning Committee updates and report. Committee chair Davis and Olivia Sanchez gave a report on the Committee's work to expand recycling and composting infrastructure.
- VII. County disposal system update. Per Art Rivera, Colton Landfill will be kept open for another three years, looking into way to keep it open even longer.
- **VIII. WDA update.** Per **Art Rivera**, 14 cities have agreed to extend their Waste Delivery Agreements (WDA) agreements for an additional 3½ years. The County has submitted proposals to import Los Angeles County waste into the County owned waste system.
- **IX. SWAT agenda recommendations / new business.** Per **Olivia Sanchez**, there may be two additions to the SWAT; applications have been filled out and need to be submitted for approval and put on as an agenda item for the upcoming SWAT meeting.
