First 5 California Background

- First 5 CA dedicated \$24 M over 5 years to help counties create a sustainable, unified system that supports home visiting efforts within a coordinated early childhood system of care
- Two funding stages
- Two components (Stage 1):
 - Local county Funding
 - Statewide TA



Home Visiting System (HVS) framework



The ultimate goal of the framework is to create an **“efficient, coordinated and sustainable local home visiting”** that serves more families, increases interconnected local early childhood systems, and builds networks of cross-county coordination and collaboration.



Project Teams



Provides funding to help counties coordinate implementation of **evidence-based home visiting programs**



HVS Collaborative



First 5 San Bernardino, El Sol and Harder+Company will partner to ensure appropriate partner engagement through a Home Visiting System Collaborative.

This collaborative will **support the development of a HVS strategic plan and core implementation components.**



Equity Framework

The development of a coordinated system will be done within an equity framework designed to intentionally **address racial, ethnic and other demographic differences** in maternal and infant health outcomes.

A critical component of this approach will be engaging leaders representing communities **who have not traditionally participated in leadership roles** in county-wide initiatives.

Phase 1 – Environmental scan




October 2020 – May 2021

- Collect and analyze indicator data
- Conduct interview and focus groups
- Research and direct outreach to home visiting programs
- Create visuals including GIS maps overlays for geographic analysis



Phase 2 – HVS Partner Engagement




November 2020 – June 2022 (ongoing)

- Stakeholder power-mapping exercise, criteria and outreach for members, ongoing support of stakeholder group members as necessary



Phase 3 – HVS Strategic Plan and Core Objectives



July 2021 - June 2022

- Draft Strategic Plan
- Revise Strategic Plan
- Present plan to Commission and other groups as appropriate



Phase 4 – HVS Leadership team and workgroups



January 2021 - June 2022

- Develop a collaboration charter
- Develop tools and document to support sustainability
- Foster reflection and learning
- Hold equity framework front and center in the work



Commitment from Stakeholders

- Participate in regular planning meetings to develop a strategic framework between now and **June 2022**
- Complete small tasks between meetings to help push work forward (for example, review data)
- Update/educate stakeholders in your organization and networks about this effort
