ADDENDUM NO. 2 to Investing in Children RFPs

Subsections 2 and 3 of Section IV (C) (2) (a) of the RFP (Health 11-02, Education 11-03 & Family 11-04) are hereby deleted. The following requirement remains: “Board of Directors: Organization’s governing board must meet not less than four times per year.” All other provisions would remain unchanged. (pg. 14)

Bullet 15 of Section XII, Item C. Proposal Format, (RFP Health 11-02, Education 11-03 & Family 11-04) is in error. There is no attachment J to be included in the proposal package submission. (pg. 37)

EXHIBIT A of the RFP 11-02 Health Services- Oral Health Strategy, Service Delivery Approach should read, “Dentist Recruitment and Retention for Pediatric Services”. Pediatric Dentist Recruitment and Retention are hereby deleted. (pg. 1 of 11)

EXHIBIT A of the RFP 11-02 Health Services- Oral Health Services Funding Requirements and Expectations should read: *Proposers meeting the minimum requirements are encouraged to apply. In addition to the minimum requirements outlined in the RFP, these specific and targeted program requirements apply to the Oral Health Service Providers and Dentist Recruitment and Retention providers.*

Program Focus: Dentist Recruitment and Retention

- Must identify and recruit dentists that need additional training in order to serve the 0 – 5 population and are willing to develop or expand to include Medi-Cal eligible children birth – 3

Or

- must develop a network of qualified volunteer dentists to provide pediatric dental services

Pediatric Dentist Recruitment and Retention are hereby deleted. (pg. 8 of 11)

EXHIBIT A of the RFP 11-02 Education Services – Pre-K Academy Funding Requirements and Expectations shall include the following additional bullets:

- **Must be able to achieve outcomes utilizing a proposed curriculum with a focus on social emotional development including social expression, self-regulation self-care, as well as motor skill and language development**
- **All Pre-K Academy programs must meet a minimum of a 3 hour day; with no limitation on how many days per week.**
- **Pre-K Academy programs must not exceed a 4 hour day (which distinguishes this preschool experience from actual F5 funded preschool program); with no limitation of days per program**
- **Can implement a program that operates during off-track or closed sessions for a minimum of 3 hour days**
- **Can implement programs that do not cross fiscal years (A fiscal year is: July 1 – June 30)**
- **Must implement parent participation/parent involvement**

Bullet 6: Must implement program during off-track or closed sessions for a minimum of 4-hour days are hereby deleted. (pg. 3 of 5)
