ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS
316 N. MOUNTAIN VIEW AVENUE (PARKING LOT 7)

The Project and Facilities Management Department (PFMD) is announcing the County's first electric vehicle charging stations for employee use located at 316 N. Mountain View Avenue.

Overview

 Parking Lot 7 (Exhibit A) was recently constructed with badge reader access and facilities for ten (10) EV chargers. Parking Lot 7 access is being extended to those employees with electric vehicles and the desire to access Parking Lot 7 for purposes of charging electric vehicles.

User Information

- Parking Lot 7 is not a general employee parking lot and is reserved for specific County and Courts staff, therefore once an employee has concluded their charging session, that employee must relocate their vehicle to their usual parking lot location. Due to limited availability of charging site, charging is encouraged to only be used when needed, and not as everyday parking.
- Charging facilities are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

User Information (continued)

- County Code 16.0209 established EV charging fees which shall be \$0.32/kWh (plus all vendor operator fees at actual cost) if vehicle is charging (4-hour maximum charge time), plus \$0.20/minute overstay fee after a 10-minute grace period (\$12.00/hour, maximum of \$48.00).
- The vehicle charging stations are operated through the LOOP EV charging network. The app is available for download to any smartphone device through the app store.
