Brian answered that the data depends on if and when the teens take the survey. Dr. Sequiera also mentioned that they get data from the Child Death Review Team (CDRT) and that info is reported in real time. • Diana Alexander asked if they are checking overlying data for certain areas that report higher numbers for teen suicide, to see if there are other problems that affect or contribute to the suicides. Brian answered that he would like to work with other agencies so that can be determined, instead of agencies working independently.
