Purpose

The purpose is to encourage classroom volunteers to actively participate in mealtimes to uphold the family style meal procedure.

Policy overview

All toddlers, preschool children, and assigned classroom staff, including volunteers, eat together family style and share the same menu to the extent possible.

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Policy

Encourage volunteers who are present during mealtimes to participate in all aspects of family style meals.

Food handler cards

Classroom volunteers are not required to have a Food Handler's Card to participate in meals. If they help a child serve a meal, they must have a Food Handler's Card.

Individuals participating in the Apprentice and WEX programs are required to have a Food Handler's Card since their ultimate goals is employment.

Any volunteer working in the kitchen is required to have a current San Bernardino County Food Handler's Card.

Reminders

Remind volunteers to:

- Practice the same hand washing procedures as children and staff
- Use gloves when opening milk or touching food directly
- Allow children to serve themselves during mealtimes and assist as needed
- Keep meal times positive and conversation child focused
- Eat child size portions with the children
