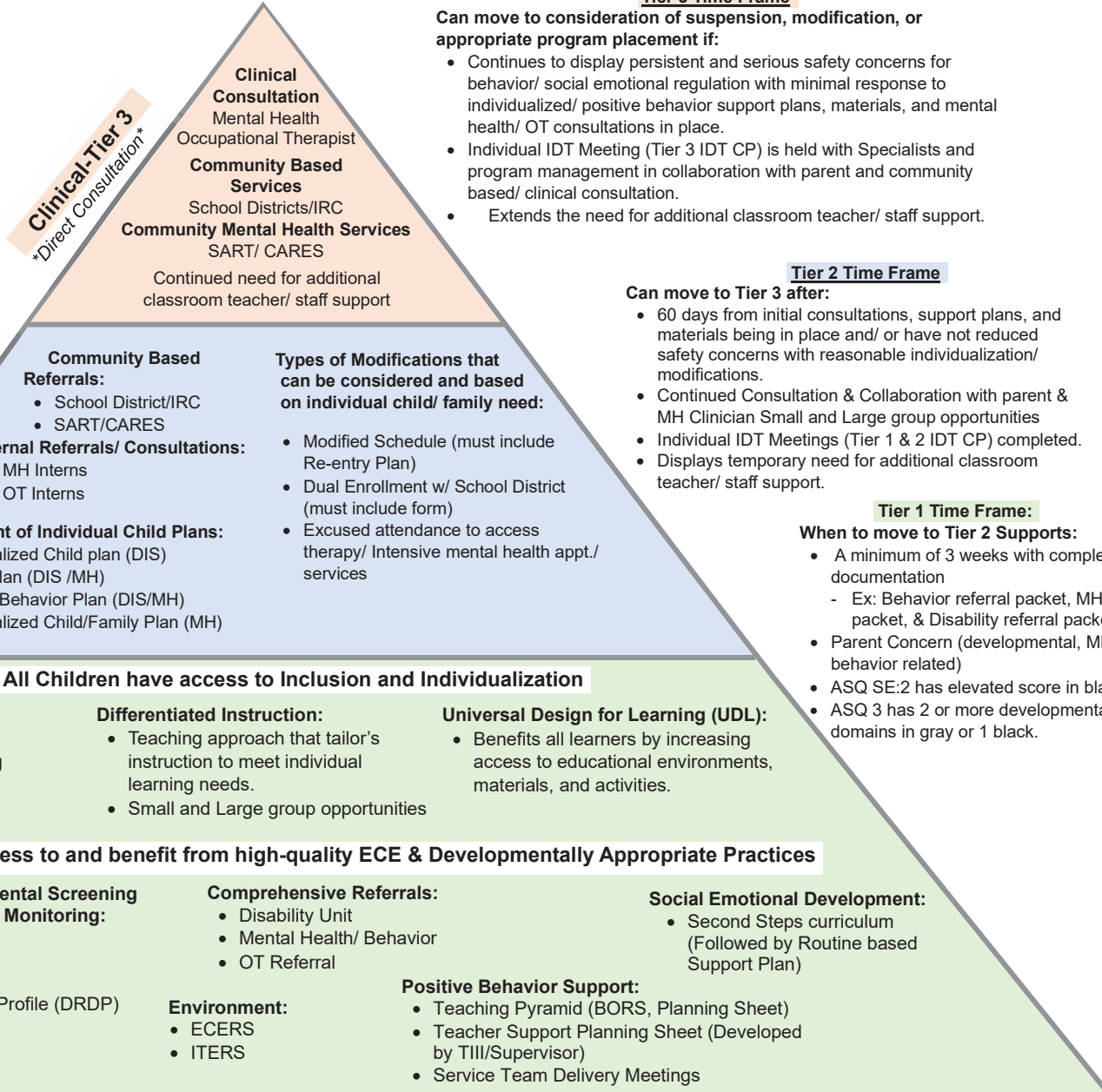
- Suspensions:**
- For children that are displaying persistent and serious safety concerns in a group care setting.
 - Must be in consultation and collaboration with mental health, parent, specialists, and program manager.
 - Is temporary in nature and must include a plan for the child to return to program.

Community Based Mental Health Services:

- Victor Community SART
- Desert Mountain SELPA CARES/ SART
- Lutheran Social Services & Vista Guidance Center
- West End SART

Community Based Early Intervention Services:

- School District Special Education Supports & Services
- Inland Regional Center (IRC) Early Start Services



Immediate Referrals to Tier 2 Specialist:

- Active IEP/IFSP that indicates behavior goals, behavior intervention plan (BIP), or intensive behavior services.
- Intensive Community Based Mental Health Services:
 - Victor Valley Community SART, West End SART, Desert Mountains SELPA/CARES
- Medical Diagnosis/Evaluations that indicate behavior, speech, or developmental recommendations/ accommodations.
- Foster Care Children with Passport of current services.
