Measure O makes perfect sense. It's the only source of funding that will directly benefit local students - and can't be raided by State government.

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Ongoing, State-imposed budget cuts certainly have created challenges for our schools. State government has cut \$21 million (almost 22%) from local schools' budget since 2008-09. Despite this, our schools have done a terrific job protecting vital programs and providing quality education to local students. And it's simply false to claim that YCJUSD Board members support statewide tax increases.

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Local schools and classrooms need essential repairs and upgrades today - and the State won't pay for them.

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Measure O is the solution. Every penny stays in Yucaipa and Calimesa.

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Currently, many local schools are at least 40 years old: leaky roofs, outdated plumbing and electrical systems, and deteriorated, inadequate classrooms and restrooms are a reality.

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Job training classrooms and labs must be improved. Yucaipa and Calimesa schools lack instructional and vocational technology needed to prepare local students to compete in the 21st century economy - whether or not students plan to attend four-year college.
