The Airport is a vital asset for military aircraft transiting the local airspace.

The Local Agency Formation Commission is requiring that the Yucca Valley Airport District ("District") secure a revenue stream for maintenance and operations of the Airport or cease to exist as a public entity. Local airports also offer benefits inherent with access to the nation's air transportation system.

With only minimum support from the State, the Airport has been operating with limited income from airport users and transient tie down fees. New revenues from Measure Z will not only support a more professional and safer Airport, but may also help stabilize or increase depressed home values in the community.

All revenues from Measure Z will be expended exclusively for the funding of operations and maintenance of the Airport's facilities.
