Observation Schedule City of San Bernardino General Election

The City of San Bernardino General Election will be held on February, 4 2014.

The public is invited to observe and participate as the San Bernardino County Elections Office conducts a series of public events related to the election. All events will take place at the San Bernardino County Elections Office according to the following schedule:

- **January 6, 2014** – Processing of Mail Ballot return envelopes begins at 8 a.m. and is performed daily, Monday through Friday, until the daily workload is complete.
- **January 16, 2014** – Logic and Accuracy Testing on the County’s voting systems will be held at 10 a.m. and is estimated to take two hours.
- **January 17, 2014** – The random precinct and batch selection for the one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners takes place at 4 p.m.
- **January 24, 2014** – Counting of Mail Ballots begins at 8 a.m. and continues periodically Monday through Friday until the daily workload is complete.
- **February 4, 2014** – Counting of polling place ballots begins shortly after the polls close at 8 p.m. and continues until complete.
- **February 5, 2014** – The official canvass begins at 8 a.m. and will be completed on or before May 6, 2014.
- **February 7, 2014**– The 100 percent manual tally of all votes cast on touchscreen voting units during the early voting period and on Election Day begins at 10 a.m.
- **February 10, 2014**– The one percent manual tally of the ballots counted on the high-speed ballot scanners begins at 9 a.m.
