**Voter Registration Deadline  
State Senate District 23 Special Primary Election**

Monday, March 10, 2014 is the deadline for State Senate District 23 residents to register to vote in the March 25, 2014 State Senate District 23 Special Primary Election. Mailed registration forms must be postmarked no later than Monday, March 10, 2014 in order to be valid for this election.

Citizens may register to vote online on the Secretary of State's website at [www.registertovote.ca.gov](http://www.registertovote.ca.gov). Registration forms are also available throughout San Bernardino County at post offices, libraries, offices of city clerks, and the Department of Motor Vehicles. A full list is available at [www.sbcountyelections.com](http://www.sbcountyelections.com).

To register to vote in California, a person must be:

- A United States citizen
- A resident of California
- At least 18 years old on Election Day
- Not in prison, on parole, serving a state prison sentence in County jail, serving a sentence for a felony pursuant to subdivision (h) of Penal Code section 1170, or on post-release community supervision
- Not found by a court to be mentally incompetent

Voters who have moved recently must re-register to vote.
